Chapter 202

RESOLVE, Providing for Completion of Dairy Barn at Augusta State Hospital.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the original barn and equipment at this institution were lost by fire; and

Whereas, it is necessary to have suitable quarters for the present herd; and

Whereas, the insurance proceeds from this loss are inadequate to construct proper unit and equip the same and provide proper storage space; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Completion of dairy barn at Augusta state hospital; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$25,000 for the construction of 2 silos and other necessary construction and equipment as may be found necessary to complete additions to the dairy barn at the Augusta state hospital, to be expended with the approval of the governor and council.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 203

RESOLVE, Providing for the Payment of Certain Pauper Claims.

Claims, appropriation and payment of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the cities, towns, counties and persons hereinafter named, the sums set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$12,620.15, being a full and final settlement of all claims against the state of Maine as listed herein.
