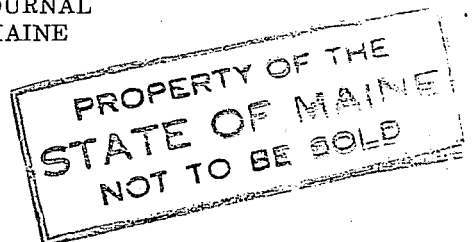

Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1949 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.
