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**Chapter 1**

**AN ACT Relating to Fees of Disclosure Commissioners.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 107, § 42, amended. The 1st sentence of section 42 of chapter 107 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The magistrate shall be entitled to 25c for each subpoena, ~~75c~~ \$1 for entry, ~~25c~~ 50c for capias, ~~25c~~ 50c for certificate, and \$3 for each day in hearing the disclosure and other testimony, and for entering default, 25c.'

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**Chapter 2**

**AN ACT to Provide for a Self-Imposed Tax on Sardines for an Industry Development Fund.**

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas the packing and merchandising of sardines is one of the most important industries of the state and a benefit to the public generally; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary to furnish employment and enhance the livelihood of the coastal and other people of Maine; and
