EMPLOYEES IN LICENSED PREMISES

Chapter 86

AN ACT Relating to Markers Designating Certain Waters and Mountains.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 80, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 80 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The necessary markers shall be made at the state prison under the direction of the warden thereof. The commission is authorized to use any funds available for the construction of state highways and bridges and for the maintenance of the same for carrying out the provisions of this section.'

Chapter 87

AN ACT Relating to Eligibility for Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-E, amended. Section 22-E of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 259 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended by adding after the 3rd sentence thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'No license shall be issued to a corporation any of the principal officers of which would not by reason of conviction of violation of any liquor laws or because of having had his license for sale of liquor revoked personally be eligible for a liquor license.'

Chapter 88

AN ACT Relating to Employment of Certain Persons in Premises Licensed to Sell Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-E-1, additional. Chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 22-E-1, to read as follows:
