#### Chapter 199

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Register of Probate of York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of register of probate of York county, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'York, \$2,500 \$2,750.'

#### Chapter 200

AN ACT Relating to Transportation of Fish from Moosehead Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 49, amended. The last 2 sentences of section 49 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'Fish taken from Moosehead lake, Rangeley lake, Mooselucmeguntic lake, Cupsuptic lake, Upper Richardson lake and Lower Richardson lake shall be limited to I shipment in any I calendar year. Shipments may be made at any time of fish taken from Moosehead lake and the waters situated in Piscataguis county.'
