## Chapter 391

### AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Deputy Register of Deeds and Clerks in the Office of Register of Deeds in Cumberland County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to the salary of the deputy register of deeds and clerk hire in the office of the register of deeds in Cumberland county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$15,500~~ \$21,000; ~~with the additional sum of \$4,500, which additional sum shall be available for the period of 2 years from the effective date hereof;~~ deputy register of deeds, ~~\$2,450~~ \$2,675;'

## Chapter 392

### AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction Over Highways on Indian Island.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 20, § 20, amended. Section 20 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 20. Commission directed to include roads on Indian Island and in Indian Township in state highway system. The commission is directed to take over as a part of the state highway system all the roads on Indian Island, Penobscot county, in Pleasant Point and Indian Township in Washington county and the bridge between Indian Island and Old Town. Said roads and bridge may be reconstructed from time to time as in the judgment of the commission is necessary, and the expense thereof, except as otherwise provided in section 28, shall be paid from funds available for the construction of state highways.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 20, § 48, amended. Section 48 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 48. Maintenance of highways and bridges on Indian Island and in Indian Township. The ~~Roads~~ roads in Indian Township and bridge
