Chapter 27

AN ACT Relating to the Trustees of the Ministerial Funds of the Town of Bridgton.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Mass. Laws, 1819, c. CII, § 2, amended. The last part of section 2 of chapter CII of the laws of Massachusetts passed in the year 1819 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that all vacancies shall be filled from, and all trustees shall be, inhabitants of the town of Bridgton, and from such as are members of the Congregational Society there provided further, that a majority of the trustees shall at all times be members of the Congregational Church of South Bridgton.'

Chapter 28

AN ACT to Ratify and Confirm the Incorporation of First Parish of Freeport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Incorporation of First Parish of Freeport ratified. The incorporation of First Parish of Freeport, in the county of Cumberland, is hereby declared to be in existence and to have been in existence since its incorporation; and all the acts of the members, officers and directors of said corporation, as such, prior to the effective date of this act, are hereby ratified and confirmed; and the register of deeds in and for the county of Cumberland is hereby authorized and instructed to enter upon his records this validation of the incorporation of First Parish of Freeport in accordance with this act.
