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## CHAP. 38

## PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1951

166 of the private and special laws of 1947, as amended by chapter 63 of the private and special laws of 1949, are hereby extended for and during a period of 2 years from August 13, 1951, and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said chapter, as amended, may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as provided in said chapter, as amended.

## Chapter 37

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the City of Ellsworth School District.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 9, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 9 of the private and special laws of 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Incorporation; name; purposes. Subject to the provisions of sections 7 and 9 hereof, the inhabitants of and the territory within the city of Ellsworth are hereby created a body politic and corporate under the name of "City of Ellsworth School District" for the purpose of acquiring property within the said city for school and related athletic and recreational purposes; for the purpose of erecting, enlarging, repairing, equipping and maintaining on said property a school building or school buildings for high school purposes and related athletic and recreational facilities; ~~for the purpose of completing, grading, furnishing, rebuilding, renovating and otherwise bettering the condition of any or all buildings within said city used for school purposes or which may hereafter be used for school purposes;~~ for the purpose of leasing or letting any property of said district to said city; for the purpose of receiving, accepting and holding gifts, grants or devises of property real, personal or mixed to be used for school and related athletic and recreational purposes; all for the benefit of the inhabitants of said city.'
