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## Chapter 88

### AN ACT Ratifying Town Meeting of the Town of Hancock.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, the town of Hancock on March 12, 1951, held its annual town meeting; and

Whereas, the warrant for such meeting was not a true and attested copy as provided by law; and

Whereas, all acts, elections and appropriations made at the meeting are therefore invalidated; and

Whereas, in order for the affairs of the town to operate for the year 1951 it is necessary that such town meeting be made valid; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**Town meeting of town of Hancock ratified.** The town warrant for the annual town meeting of the town of Hancock held the 12th day of March, 1951, all votes passed at said meeting, all officers elected and qualified and all appropriations made are hereby ratified, confirmed and made legal.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
