PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1951

Chapter 110

AN ACT Relating to the Protection of Alewives in East Machias River in the Town of East Machias.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Protection of alewives in town of East Machias. No person shall take, catch or kill any alewives in the East Machias river in the town of East Machias, Washington county, except on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 7 A. M. to 8 P. M., beginning the 1st day of May and ending the 1st day of July. This right shall apply to the residents of East Machias only. One person shall own only 1 fish stand at a time. Fish stands shall not exceed 18 feet in length and they shall be at least 10 feet apart. No breakwater shall exceed 3 feet. There shall be a channel of at least 25 feet running between stands and no rock walls or other obstacles shall be allowed in said channel. Weirs may be attended at any time between 7 A. M. on Mondays to 8 P. M. on Wednesdays.

Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall be punished by a fine of \$50.

Chapter 111

AN ACT to Incorporate the Town of Kittery School District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. r. Town of Kittery School District, incorporated. Subject to the provisions of this act, the inhabitants of and the territory within the town of Kittery shall constitute a body politic and corporate under the name of "Town of Kittery School District" for the purpose of acquiring property within the said town for school and related athletic and recreational purposes; for the purpose of erecting, enlarging, repairing, equipping and maintaining on said property a school building, or school buildings for school purposes and related athletic and recreational facilities; for the purpose of leasing or letting any property of said district to said town; for the purpose of receiving, accepting and holding gifts, grants or devises of property, real, personal or mixed, to be used for school and related athletic and recreational purposes; all for the benefit of the inhabitants of said district.
