Chapter 159

AN ACT Relating to Salary of the Judge of the Pittsfield Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1923, c. 34, § 1, amended. The 1st sentence of section 1 of chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1923, as amended by chapter 113 of the private and special laws of 1931, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of the municipal court of Pittsfield shall receive a salary of ~~one thousand dollars~~ \$1,500 per year ~~from and after July first, nineteen hundred thirty one~~, which shall be paid him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Somerset county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge.'

Chapter 160

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Judge and the Recorder of the Millinocket Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 393, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 393 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended by chapter 98 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salaries of judge and recorder; clerk hire. The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all services, of ~~\$1,700~~ \$2,000 per annum to be paid him by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of ~~\$1,100~~ \$1,200 per annum, payable ~~quarterly~~ monthly, and such additional amount for clerk hire as may be authorized by the county commissioners.'
