Chapter 180

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Northern Aroostook Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1947, c. 38, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 38 of the private and special laws of 1947 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,100 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

Chapter 181

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Van Buren Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1947, c. 54, § 1, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 54 of the private and special laws of 1947 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,100 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'
