Chapter 7

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in the Towns of Bucksport and Verona.

Fishing in towns of Bucksport and Verona. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to repeal the rule and regulation granting to the towns of Bucksport and Verona, in the county of Hancock, the right to fish with seines along the bridge connecting said towns.

Chapter 8

RESOLVE, Relating to the Taking of Alewives from Walker's Brook.

Taking of alewives from Walker's brook regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue the following rule and regulation:

It shall be unlawful for any person to take, in any manner, more than 1 peck of alewives per day from the waters of Walker's brook, so called, that run between Walker's pond and the Bagaduce river, in the town of Brooksville; and be it further

Resolves, 1935, c. 7, repealed. Resolved: That chapter 7 of the resolves of 1935 be, and hereby is, repealed.

Chapter 9

RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Clams in the Town of East Machias.

Taking of clams in East Machias, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue the following rule and regulation:

'Regulating the taking of clams in East Machias. It shall be unlawful for any person not a resident of the town of East Machias, Washington county, to dig or take in any manner any clams, quahogs or mussels from the shores and flats on the north side of Machias river beginning at the toll bridge and running easterly along said Machias river and continuing in a northerly direction along the East Machias river.'
