## Chapter 13

### RESOLVE, in Favor of Sylvia B. Holden, of Moose River.

**Sylvia B. Holden; retirement benefit granted. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, granted to Sylvia B. Holden, of Moose River, a retirement benefit of \$64.57 per month during her lifetime, to be paid from the funds of the Maine state retirement system. Said monthly retirement benefits shall be retroactive to September 8, 1949. The retirement benefit, or any part thereof, shall not be payable until the sum of \$982.19, contributed to the Maine Retirement System and refunded to the said Sylvia B. Holden shall be repaid to the state.

## Chapter 14

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in DeMeyers Brook, in the County of Hancock.

**Fishing in DeMeyers brook, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing DeMeyers brook in the town of Eastbrook, in the county of Hancock, to all fishing.

## Chapter 15

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Lincoln Plantation, County of Oxford.

**Fishing in Lincoln plantation, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing the tributaries to Magalloway river from Aziscohos dam to the New Hampshire line, namely; Meadow brook, Bennett brook, Town Hall brook and Clark brook in Lincoln plantation, county of Oxford.

Effective August 20, 1951
