CHAP. 18

Chapter 16

RESOLVE, Closing Certain Ponds in York County to Fishing.

Certain ponds in York county, closed to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Folly pond, Middle pond and Boulter pond, so called, all in the town of York, York county, to fishing during all seasons of the year.

Chapter 17

RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Speck Ponds in Oxford County.

Resolves, 1945, c. 107, amended. That part of chapter 107 of the resolves of 1945 which relates to Two Specks pond in Oxford county is hereby amended as follows and to be inserted in alphabetical order:

'Two Speeks pond Waterford

Speck Ponds (2) Norway.'

Chapter 18

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in the Brook between West Richardson Pond and the Pepper Pot in the County of Oxford.

Fishing in the brook between West Richardson pond and the Pepper Pot, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing the brook between West Richardson pond and the Pepper Pot in Adamstown in the county of Oxford.
