RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Sourdnahunk and Little Sourdnahunk Lakes in the County of Piscataquis.

Fishing in Sourdnahunk and Little Sourdnahunk lakes, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Sourdnahunk lake and Little Sourdnahunk lake in T. 4, R. 10 and 11, T. 5, R. 10 and 11, W. E. L. S., in the county of Piscataquis, to all fishing from 1 hour after sunset to 1 hour before sunrise the following morning of each day.
