Chapter 54

RESOLVE, Limiting the Catch of Trout or Salmon in Adams Pond in the Town of Boothbay.

Catch of trout or salmon in Adams pond, limited. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation limiting the catch of trout or salmon in Adams pond, so called, in the town of Boothbay, to 5 fish per person per day.

Chapter 55

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Province Lake, York County.

Fishing in Province lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to regulate fishing in Province lake, York county, so as to conform to the fishing regulations of that part of the lake that lies in New Hampshire.

Chapter 56

RESOLVE, Relating to Closed Season for White Perch in Echo Lake, Kennebec County.

Echo lake; closed season for white perch in. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Echo lake, Kennebec county, to fishing for white perch until June 21st of each year.
