Chapter 77

RESOLVE, Extending Appropriation of Money to Improve the Approach to the Fish Way at Aroostook Falls.

Resolves, 1947, c. 146, amended. Resolved: That the last paragraph of chapter 146 of the resolves of 1947, as enacted by chapter 53 of the resolves of 1949 be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

'All unexpended balances shall not lapse until June 30, 1951 1953, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1951 1953.'

Chapter 78

RESOLVE, Relating to Taking Crabs in Cumberland County.

Rule and regulation. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to prohibit fishing for, taking or catching crabs in any manner in the county of Cumberland from December 15th to March 15th, inclusive.

Chapter 79

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Stockholm.

Debt of town of Stockholm; cancelled. Resolved: That the county commissioners of Aroostook county be, and hereby are, authorized to cancel the debt up to January I, 1950, for excise taxes for motor vehicles received from persons residing in unorganized territory.
