Chapter 90

RESOLVE, in Favor of Dwight D. Dixon, of Clinton.

Dwight D. Dixon; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$67.50 to be paid to Dwight D. Dixon, of Clinton, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for 45 hens killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

Chapter 91

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Franklin County.

Fishing in certain waters in Franklin county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue the following rules and regulations:

1. To permit fly fishing only in Blanchard pond, in Davis and Lang townships, Franklin county, with a daily bag limit of 6 fish.
2. To permit fly fishing only in Mud pond, in township 2, range 4, Franklin county, with a daily bag limit of 10 fish.
3. To permit fly fishing only in Northwest pond, Franklin county, with a daily bag limit of 6 fish or 5 pounds, and to close all tributaries to Northwest pond to all fishing.
4. To close all tributaries to Little Kennebago stream, in Davis and Stetson townships, Franklin county, to all fishing.

Certain ponds in Aroostook county limited to fly fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation limiting, to fly fish-
