Chapter 105

RESOLVE, in Favor of Peter Spanos, of Portland.

Peter Spanos; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$104.70 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game to Peter Spanos, of Portland, to reimburse him for money collected by the Western Oxford Municipal court on October 26, 1949 for violation of an inland fisheries and game law.

Chapter 106

RESOLVE, in Favor of George Panages, of Portland.

George Panages; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$104.70 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game to George Panages, of Portland, to reimburse him for money collected by the Western Oxford Municipal court on October 26, 1949 for violation of an inland fisheries and game law.

Chapter 107

RESOLVE, Authorizing Maine General Hospital to Convey Certain Lands to Maine Medical Center.

Maine General Hospital to convey certain lands. Resolved: That Maine General Hospital be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Maine Medical Center, a Maine corporation, all or any part of the lot of land with the buildings thereon, situated on Bramhall's Hill in the city of Portland, being the former site of the State Arsenal, conveyed to it by the state of Maine by chapter 180 of the resolves of the State of Maine, 1870, on condition that such land shall be used by Maine Medical Center for hospital purposes and that when such land ceases to be so used, it shall revert to the state.
