Chapter 108

RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles Norton Pratt, of Leeds.

Charles Norton Pratt; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$400 from the state highway fund to be paid to Charles Norton Pratt, of Leeds, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his buildings caused by the state widening and raising the grade of the highway in front of said buildings. Provided, however, that the said Pratt shall give to the state a release of damages.

Chapter 109

RESOLVE, Dividing the State into Executive Councillor Districts.

Apportionment executive councillor districts. Resolved: That for the years 1953 to and including the year 1962, the state is hereby divided into 7 councillor districts, each of which districts shall be entitled to 1 councillor to be chosen in the manner prescribed by the constitution and laws of the state, as follows:

First District: York, 1953-54, 1955-56, 1961-62. Oxford, 1957-58, 1959-60.

Second District: Cumberland, 1 for each year.

Third District: Sagadahoc, 1953-54. Androscoggin, 1955-56, 1959-60, 1961-62. Franklin, 1957-58.

Fourth District: Somerset, 1953-54, 1955-56. Kennebec, 1957-58, 1959-60, 1961-62.

Fifth District: Lincoln, 1953-54. Waldo, 1955-56. Hancock, 1957-58, 1959-60. Knox, 1961-62.

Sixth District: Piscataquis, 1953-54. Penobscot, 1955-56, 1957-58, 1959-60, 1961-62.

Seventh District: Washington, 1953-54, 1955-56. Aroostook, 1957-58, 1959-60, 1961-62.
