Chapter 137

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys to Obtain Plasma.

Plasma; appropriating moneys to obtain. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$15,375 for the purpose of supplying materials in connection with the accumulation, storage and maintenance of 5,000 units of liquid plasma and 500 units of dried plasma to be available in the event of a disaster; this money to be expended upon authorization by the department of health and welfare. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account.

Chapter 138

RESOLVE, in Favor of State Military Defense Commission.

State military defense commission; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$20,000 from the general fund to remodel certain property to be used as an Armory-Community Center in Waterville to be matched to the extent of at least a 50-50 basis by the communities.

Chapter 139

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Automatic Emergency Electric Power for State Police Radio System.

Automatic emergency electric power for state police; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general

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fund to the chief of the state police the sum of \$11,650 for the installation of automatic emergency electric power. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account.

Chapter 140

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine Historical Society.

Maine Historical Society; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Maine Historical Society, the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, and the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953; the same to be paid in quarterly payments commencing on October 1, 1951; said sum to be taken from the general fund.

RESOLVE, in Favor of Knox Memorial Association, Inc. for Support and Maintenance of "Montpelier."

Knox Memorial Association, Inc.; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Knox Memorial Association, Inc., the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, and the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, to aid in the support and maintenance of "Montpelier," replica of the home of Major General Henry Knox, located at Thomaston, Maine.

RESOLVE, Restoring the Frederick Robie Library Fund.

Frederick Robie Library Fund; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$2,000 to restore the original principal of the trust fund known as the Frederick Robie Library Fund of the Augusta State Hospital; and be it further
