CHAP. 171

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Effective May 21, 1951

## Chapter 169

**RESOLVE, Providing for Certain Construction at the Maine State Airport.**

**Maine state airport; appropriation for construction. Resolved:** That the sum of \$143,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be used with matching federal funds for extension of the northwest-southeast runway and lighting system at the state airport, at Augusta, so said airport may be usable and safe for present air traffic.

Effective August 20, 1951

## Chapter 170

**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Robert Ballard, of Hallowell.**

**Robert Ballard, compensated. Resolved:** That the sum of \$512.30 is hereby appropriated to be paid to Robert Ballard, of Hallowell, in full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to his tractor. The said sum shall be taken from the fund for state school for girls' farm operations.

## Chapter 171

**RESOLVE, Providing for the Payment of Certain Pauper Claims.**

**Claims, appropriation and payment thereof. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the cities, towns, counties and persons hereinafter named, the sums set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$22,674.14, being a full and final settlement of all claims against the state of Maine as listed herein.

Town of Albion, for burial expenses for Charles B. Denanco of Unity	\$ 100.00
City of Bangor, for burial expenses for old age recipients	200.00
