## Chapter 19

### AN ACT Relating to Punishment of Liquor Licensees.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'Licensees ordered in for hearing as herein provided shall bring with them their licenses but the notice of hearing shall authorize the licensee to operate his licensed business the day of the said hearing, and all penalties imposed by the commission shall start the day following the hearing.'

## Chapter 20

### AN ACT Relating to Recording of Contracts for Conditional Sale of Railroad Equipment.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 42, § 99, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 99 of chapter 42 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'II. Such instrument shall be filed for record in the office of the secretary of state or with the interstate commerce commission pursuant to the provisions of the interstate commerce act;'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 42, § 100, amended. Section 100 of chapter 42 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'The provisions of this section shall not apply if such contracts are filed with the interstate commerce commission pursuant to the provisions of subsection II of section 99.'
