voted exclusively to the purposes for which it is organized, and that the institution, association or corporation claiming exemption under the provisions of this subsection shall file with the tax assessors upon their request a report for its preceding fiscal year in such detail as the tax assessors may reasonably require. Any college in this state authorized to confer the degree of bachelor of arts or of bachelor of science and having real estate liable to taxation shall, on the payment of such tax and proof of the same to the satisfaction of the governor and council, be reimbursed from the state treasury to the amount of the tax so paid; provided, however, that the aggregate amount so reimbursed to any college in any one year shall not exceed \$1,500 and that this right of reimbursement shall not apply to real estate bought after April 12, 1889.'

Chapter 38

AN ACT Relating to Payment of Certain County Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The clerks of the judicial courts in the several counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties in monthly or weekly payments ~~paid on the last day of each month~~, as follows.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The sheriffs of the several counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties in monthly or weekly payments ~~paid on the last day of each month~~, as follows.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Registers of deeds in the several counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties in monthly or weekly payments ~~paid on the last day of each month~~, as follows.'
