'In all cases where books with printed forms are not furnished therefor, registers of deeds shall receive for receiving, filing and recording any instrument by law entitled to record, the sum of \$2 for the first 500 words, and the sum of 20c for each 100 words or fraction thereof in excess of 500 words, provided however that if recording is done by photographic, photo-static or other mechanical methods as permitted by law the charge shall be \$1 for each record page or fraction of a record page so recorded. If the instrument contains the names of more than 2 parties thereto, other than the husband and wife of the grantor or grantee, an additional fee of 25c each shall be charged for indexing the names of additional grantors or grantees or other parties thereto.'

Chapter 51

AN ACT Relating to Payment to Lincoln County Law Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 151, amended. That part of section 151 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to payment to the county law library association of Lincoln county, as repealed and replaced by chapter 253 of the public laws of 1945, and as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~\$500~~ \$1,000.'

Chapter 52

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county treasurer of Lincoln county, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~\$650~~ \$800.'
