Chapter 60

AN ACT Relating to State Stipend for Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 16, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 16 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'This stipend shall be divided among the legally incorporated agricultural clubs, societies, **counties** and fair associations of the state, hereafter in this chapter designated as "societies," according to the following schedule and method.'

Chapter 61

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of Deputy Clerk of Courts, Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. That part of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to the salary of the deputy clerk of courts of Penobscot county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'deputy clerk of courts, \$2,800 \$2,900,'

Chapter 62

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Judge of Probate of Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the judge of probate of Kennebec county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Kennebec, \$3,000 \$3,500,'
