AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in Office of Register of Probate, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of probate in Cumberland county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$8,500~~ \$11,700;'

Chapter 121

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of Register of Probate, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to the salary of register of probate of Cumberland county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Cumberland, ~~\$3,000~~ \$4,000,'
