Chapter 181

AN ACT Relating to the Trial Term of the Superior Court in Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 94, § 11, sub-§ XII amended. Subsection XII of section 11 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'XII. Sagadahoc: At Bath on the 2nd Tuesday of January, the 2nd Tuesday of June and the ~~3rd~~ 2nd Tuesday of October.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect as of December 1, 1953.

Chapter 182

AN ACT Relating to Aroostook County Law Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 151, amended. That part of section 151 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Aroostook county, as repealed and replaced by chapter 253 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, ~~\$1,900~~ \$2,500, of which ~~\$1,400~~ \$1,700 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Houlton in said county and \$800 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Caribou in said county.'

Chapter 183

AN ACT Repealing Laws on Street Sprinkling.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, §§ 128, 129, 130, repealed. Sections 128, 129 and 130, inclusive, of chapter 84 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed.
