Chapter 186

AN ACT Relating to the Executive Office.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 11, § 1, amended. The first 2 paragraphs of section 1 of chapter 11 of the revised statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

'The governor shall have his official residence at Augusta during his term of office, and shall keep his office at the state house open ~~either personally or by his private secretary~~ for the transaction of the business of the state during ~~business days of each week~~ all normal working hours of the state house.

~~The~~ In the absence of the governor, his private secretary shall be in attendance and the private secretary ~~of the governor~~ shall devote his entire time to the duties of his office.'

Chapter 187

AN ACT Relating to Acts of Employees of a Partnership as Insurance Agents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 56, § 251, amended. Section 251 of chapter 56 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'Provided further, that upon request of the members of a partnership the names of one or more employees, each of whom shall have qualified as an insurance agent, may be authorized to act and sign in behalf of the partnership, and such employee or employees shall be listed in licenses issued to such partnership.'
