## Chapter 330

AN ACT Relating to State Liquor Warehouse and Wholesale Store.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 57, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 144 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding after the 1st sentence thereof, a new sentence, to read as follows:

'The state warehouse and wholesale store shall be located in a place designated by the state liquor commission.'

Sec. 2. **Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated from the working capital of the Maine state liquor commission the sum of \$325,000 to carry out the purposes of this act. Such appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this act have been accomplished.

## Chapter 331

AN ACT Providing for the Classification of Certain Surface Waters.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 72, § 12, additional. Chapter 72 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 12, to read as follows:

### 'Classification of Surface Waters

Sec. 12. **Classification.** The following surface waters shall be classified in accordance with the provisions of this chapter:

#### Androscoggin River Basin

- I. The Magalloway river and its tributaries above the first crossing of the Maine-New Hampshire state line — Class A.
- II. Kennebago stream and its tributaries above its confluence with Mooselookmeguntic lake — Class A.
