Chapter 362

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Loss of Hearing Under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 26, § 13, amended. The 2nd and 3rd paragraphs from the end of section 13 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 405 of the public laws of 1949, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'For the total and permanent loss of hearing in one ear, 25 50 weeks.

For the total and permanent loss of hearing in both ears, 65 100 weeks.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall become effective on November 30, 1953.

AN ACT Repealing Law on Canning of Clams and Mussels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 93, repealed. Section 93 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed.
