Chapter 1

AN ACT Relating to Ferry Between Indian Island and Old Town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1945, c. 85, repealed. Chapter 85 of the private and special laws of 1945 is hereby repealed.

Chapter 2

AN ACT Relating to Additional Powers to Portland University.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 40, § 4, repealed and replaced. Section 4 of chapter 40 of the private and special laws of 1949, as enacted by chapter 136 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 4. Additional degrees. Portland University is hereby empowered to confer educational, literary and academic degrees, honors and certificates of proficiency as are usually conferred by like institutions of higher learning.’
