PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1953

Chapter 48

AN ACT Relative to the Salary of the Judge of the Brunswick Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1903, c. 277, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 277 of the private and special laws of 1903, as amended by chapter 63 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. II. Salary of judge. The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of \$2,500 \$3,000 in full for all services, payable quarterly on the last days of March, June, September and December from the treasury of Cumberland county.'

Chapter 49

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Recorder of the Brunswick Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1903, c. 277, § 8, amended. The 4th sentence of section 8 of chapter 277 of the private and special laws of 1903, as amended by chapter 169 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'For all services performed the said recorder shall receive from the county of Cumberland an annual salary of \$1,000 and \$600 annually additional for clerk hire, to be paid to him in quarterly payments.'
