554SALARIES INCREASED JUDGE AND RECORDER BAR HARBOR MUN. CT.CHAP. 66PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1953

1945, which amended chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1911, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The judge shall reside at Houlton. He shall be appointed, and shall give bond in accordance with the constitution and the laws of this state. His salary shall be $\frac{23,500}{33,000}$ a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 154, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1." of chapter 63 of the private and special laws of 1945, which amended chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by section 1 of chapter 84 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be $\$_{1,250}$ \$1,650 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

Chapter 65

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Fort Fairfield Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1929, c. 67, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1." of chapter 163 of the private and special laws of 1947, which amended chapter 67 of the private and special laws of 1929, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be $\frac{2}{500}$ \$2,900 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'
