#### SALARY JUDGE OF WATERVILLE MUNICIPAL COURT 619 PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1953 CHAP. 104

special laws of 1947, which amended chapter 178 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 180 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be  $\frac{1}{2,100}$  \$2,400 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 178, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1." of chapter 38 of the private and special laws of 1947, which amended chapter 178 of the private and special laws of 1911, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$400 \$700 a year to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

#### Chapter 103

#### AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Van Buren Municipal Court.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1939, c. 18, amended.** The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1." of chapter 54 of the private and special laws of 1947, which amended chapter 18 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended by chapter 181 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$2,100 \$2,400 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'
