necessary town officers, including a town manager, shall be appointed as herein provided.'

**Referendum; effective date; certificate to secretary of state.** This act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the town of Camden at the next regular town meeting; or at a special town meeting to be held not later than 6 months after the effective date of this act. The town clerk shall prepare the required ballots on which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall An Act Relating to Election of Members of School Board in Town of Camden, passed by the 96th legislature, be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at said meeting, provided that the total number of votes cast for and against acceptance of this act equals or exceed 30% of the total vote cast for all candidates for governor in said town at the next previous gubernatorial election. The result of said vote shall be declared by the municipal officers of the town of Camden and due certificate thereof filed by the town clerk with the secretary of state.

## Chapter 162

### AN ACT Amending Law on Ferry Between Beals and Jonesport.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

P. & S. L., 1951, c. 135, § 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 135 of the private and special laws of 1951 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The town of Beals is authorized to employ such persons as may be necessary for the efficient and safe operation of the ferry or to lease the right to operate the same to any responsible person or persons ~~who shall be legal residents of Beals.~~
