Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

County Commissioners to transfer certain real estate. The County Commissioners of Lincoln County are hereby authorized and empowered to sell, assign, transfer and convey the right, title and interest of the County of Lincoln in and to the Old County Jail, so called, and the lot on which it stands, situated on Federal Street in Wiscasset in said County, for such consideration as they may determine.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 187

AN ACT Relating to Power of Androscoggin County to Borrow Money.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Androscoggin County finds it impossible to legally operate without the power to borrow a certain sum of money; and

Whereas, in order to perform the functions of the County under existing law it is vitally necessary that the County Commissioners of Androscoggin County be given the authority to borrow temporarily \$25,000; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Loans. The County Commissioners of Androscoggin County may obtain a loan for the use of their County and cause notes or obligations, with coupons for lawful interest, to be issued for payment thereof; such loan shall not exceed \$25,000 and shall be repaid by January 31, 1956.

Sec. 2. Repealing and amending clause. All acts and resolves or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform to the provisions of this act.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
