RESOLVES, 1953

#### Chapter 9

RESOLVE, Opening Center Pond in the Town of Lincoln to Ice Fishing.

Center pond opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Center pond in the town of Lincoln to ice fishing.

Effective August 8, 1953

#### Chapter 10

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Abbott Brook, Oxford County.

Abbott brook; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Abbott brook in the town of Mexico, Oxford county, to fishing by all persons over the age of 16, and limiting the daily catch to 5 fish per person.

Effective August 8, 1953

#### Chapter 11

RESOLVE, Opening Crane Pond to Ice Fishing.

Crane pond opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Crane pond, commonly known as the Narrows in the town of Lincoln and on the opposite side of road ½ township, lying easterly of a road leading from Lincoln to Burlington, the so-called Upper Cold Stream pond or commonly known as the Little lake, to ice fishing for perch and pickerel only.

Effective August 8, 1953

### Chapter 12

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Waterford.

Town of Waterford; money reallocated. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 appropriated in favor of the town of Waterford by the 89th legislature for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941; and the sum of \$500 appropri-
