Chapter 22

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Big Magalloway River in Oxford County.

Fishing in Big Magalloway river, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the Big Magalloway river, north of Parmachenee lake, in Oxford county, to fly fishing only with artificial unbaited flies, from September 1st to September 30th, inclusive, of each year, with a daily bag limit of 1 fish per person per day.

Chapter 23

RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Smelts in Little Big Wood Pond and Long Pond in Somerset County.

Taking of smelts in Little Wood pond and Long pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making it lawful to take smelts in the nighttime in Little Big Wood pond and in Long pond in Somerset county by using not more than 5 lines in the waters which have been opened to ice fishing by the commissioner.

Effective August 8, 1953

Chapter 24

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Sandy Stream and Heald Stream, in Jackman Plantation, Somerset County.

Sandy stream and Heald stream; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation that there be a daily bag limit of 10 fish in Sandy stream, in Jackman plantation, Somerset county; and be it further

Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation that there be a daily bag limit of 10 fish in Heald stream, in Jackman plantation, Somerset county.
