#### 918 APPROPRIATION FOR MAINE VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL INSTITUTE CHAP. 88 RESOLVES, 1953

Any person taking clams, mussels, oysters, quahogs or marine worms contrary to the provisions of these regulations shall be punished for each offense by a fine of not less than \$10, nor more than \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
