IN FAVOR OF MADAWASKA TRAINING SCHOOL RESOLVES, 1953 CHAP. 108 Facilities and Construction Act, P. L. 783, 81st Congress, to accomplish the construction of at least the minimum requirements for a one unit armory.

The moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

#### Chapter 107

#### RESOLVE, Providing for Construction of Dolphins at Maine Maritime Academy.

Maine Maritime Academy; construction of dolphins. Resolved: That the sum of \$15,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to the Maine Maritime Academy out of unappropriated surplus for the construction of dolphins to supplement the present wharf for mooring purposes; and be it further

Resolved: That the appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

### Chapter 108

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Madawaska Training School.

Madawaska Training School; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$13,900 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954 from the general fund surplus of the state for the construction of a laboratory and for certain repairs to the Madawaska Training School. This amount is made up from the items in the following schedule:

Drill Artesian Well	\$ 2,200
Surface Driveways with Tar	500
Repair Coal Storage Bin	1,000
Construction of a Laboratory	10,200
