Chapter 155

RESOLVE, in Favor of Wesley Ramsey, of South Portland.

Wesley Ramsey; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$146.55 to be paid to Wesley Ramsey, of South Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to home and personal property by escapees from the state school for boys.

Effective August 8, 1953

Chapter 156

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine Historical Society.

Maine Historical Society; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Maine Historical Society, the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954; and the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955; the same to be paid in quarterly payments commencing on October 1, 1953.

Effective August 8, 1953

Chapter 157

RESOLVE, in Favor of Robert E. Towle of Portland.

Robert E. Towle; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$107.59 from the general fund to be paid to Robert E. Towle of Portland as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car which was taken by 5 escapees from the state school for boys.

Effective August 8, 1953

Chapter 158

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Fort Fairfield.

Town of Fort Fairfield; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$358.19 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department
