RESOLVES, 1953**CHAP. 177**

Chapter 175

RESOLVE, Granting a Retirement Pension to Hugh A. Smith of Charleston.

Retirement pension granted to Hugh A. Smith. Resolved: That Hugh A. Smith, of Charleston, be given credit for 19 years of teaching service at Coburn Classical Institute so that he may be entitled to a retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes. Such retirement allowance shall not be payable until the said Hugh A. Smith has paid to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$920.

Chapter 176

RESOLVE, Closing Little Sebago Lake, Cumberland County, to Ice Fishing.

Little Sebago lake; ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Little Sebago lake, Cumberland county, to the taking of trout and salmon from October 1st to the following April 1st of each year. Said lake shall not be closed to ice fishing for perch and pickerel.

Chapter 177

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Liberty.

Town of Liberty; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Liberty, the sum of \$1,337.24
