CHAP. 200

Chapter 198

RESOLVE, in Favor of Sadie M. D. Jewell of Orono.

Sadie M. D. Jewell; to be given credit. Resolved: That Sadie M. D. Jewell of Orono be given credit for approximately 2 years of teaching service to qualify her to receive the minimum retirement benefit provided for by chapter 60, revised statutes as amended, for a teacher who has completed 25 years of creditable teaching service; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve, the sum of \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954 and \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955.

Chapter 199

RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Ida M. Fuller of Mount Vernon.

Teacher's pension granted to Ida M. Fuller. Resolved: That Ida M. Fuller, of Mount Vernon, be given credit for an additional 1 2/3 years of teaching service so that she may be entitled to a retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes, and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund for the purposes of this resolve the sum of \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954 and the sum of \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955.

RESOLVE, In Favor of Althea C. Ward, of Augusta.

Althea C. Ward; retirement allowance. Resolved: That Althea C. Ward of Augusta be granted a retirement benefit in accordance with the provisions of Option 2 as set forth in section 10 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes, as amended; said benefit to be effective as of February 24, 1953; and be it further
