Chapter 213

RESOLVE, Providing Additional Funds for the Maine State Office Building.

Additional appropriation for new office building. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$500,000 for the purpose of completing the constructing and equipping of the state office building in Augusta and to remodel State House Offices, Library and Highway Building.

The appropriation provided by the provisions of this Resolve shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

Chapter 214

RESOLVE in Favor of Maine Maritime Academy.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, appropriations for the Maine Maritime Academy have not been sufficient to carry on the functions of the Academy; and

Whereas, the education of our youth is essential and to continue this education additional funds are necessary; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Maine Maritime Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state the sum of \$18,000 to carry on the functions of the Maine Maritime Academy until June 30, 1955.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
