PUBLIC LAWS, 1955

CHAP. 45

AN ACT Defining Vessel under Public Utility Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 44, § 16, sub-§ XXIV, amended. Subsection XXIV of section 16 of chapter 44 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'XXIV. "Vessel" includes every steamboat or boat powered by diesel engines which is owned, controlled, operated or managed for public use in the transportation of persons or property for compensation within this State.'

Chapter 44**AN ACT Relating to Time of Report of Harness Racing Commission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 86, § 7, amended. Section 7 of chapter 86 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 7. Report. The Commission shall make an annual report to the Governor on or before the 1st day of ~~December~~ January in each year, including therein an account of its actions, receipts derived under the provisions of this chapter, the practical effects of the application of the provisions of this chapter and any recommendation for legislation which the Commission deems advisable.'

Chapter 45**AN ACT Relating to Boundaries of Stockholm Game Preserve.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 149, amended. That part of section 149 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes which relates to Stockholm Game Preserve is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Stockholm Game Preserve: The following described territory, situated in the town of Stockholm and T. 16, R. 4, in the county of Aroostook beginning at a point on state road No. 161 at a point where ~~Bangor & Aroostook R. R. crosses~~ the Little Madawaska River meets said highway and extending in an easterly and northerly direction along the Little Madawaska River to a point where the river and the Bangor & Aroostook R. R. meet and extending in an easterly and northerly direction along the right-of-way of said railroad approximately 6 miles to the southern boundary of T. 17, R. 3, thence west along
