CHAP. 229

Chapter 228

AN ACT Relating to Number of Employees under Group Life Insurance Policies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 60, § 164, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, amended. The second sentence of paragraph A of subsection I of section 164 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The policy may provide that the term "employees" shall include the employees of I or more subsidiary corporations, the employees of I or more corporations with which the employer, having not less than 25 10 employees of its own, is under contract to provide specified services at cost and the employees, individual proprietors and partners of I or more affiliated corporations, proprietors or partnerships if the business of the employer and of such affiliated corporations, proprietors or partnerships is under common control through stock ownership or contract.'

- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 60, § 164, sub-§ I, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection I of section 164 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'C. The policy must cover at least 25 10 employees at date of issue.'

Chapter 229

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Otter and Fisher.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ I, amended. The 5th and 6th paragraphs of subsection I of section 113 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed as follows, and the following paragraphs enacted in place thereof:

'The open season on otter shall be during the month of November and from January 4 to February 7, inclusive, of each year.

There shall be no open season on fisher and sable.

The open season on otter shall be during the month of November and from January 1 to February 28, inclusive, of each year.

There shall be an open season on fisher from November 16, 1955 to December 15, 1955, both dates inclusive, and from November 16, 1956 to December 15, 1956, both dates inclusive, in the area described as follows: North of a line formed by Route 5 from the New Hampshire Border near Fryeburg to the junction of the Appalachian Trail near South Arm, thence along the Appalachian Trail to the junction of the Canadian Pacific Railroad near Onawa Lake (Piscataquis County); thence easterly along the Canadian Pacific Railroad to junction of Bangor and Aroostook Railroad at Brownville Junction;
