## Chapter 122

AN ACT Changing Name of Rumford and Mexico Water District to Rumford Water District.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 290, § 1, amended. Wherever in section 1 of chapter 290 of the private and special laws of 1911 the words "Rumford and Mexico Water District" appear, the same are hereby amended to read 'Rumford Water District.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1915, c. 50, amended. Wherever in chapter 50 of the private and special laws of 1915 the words "Rumford and Mexico Water District" appear, they are hereby amended to read 'Rumford Water District.'

Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1925, c. 79, §§ 1 and 3, amended. Wherever in sections 1 and 3 of chapter 79 of the private and special laws of 1925 the words "Rumford and Mexico Water District" appear, they are hereby amended to read 'Rumford Water District.'

## Chapter 123

AN ACT to Grant a Charter to the Town of Brunswick.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

### TOWN CHARTER OF BRUNSWICK

#### ARTICLE I

#### GRANT OF POWERS TO THE TOWN

Sec. 101. Corporate existence retained. The inhabitants of the town of Brunswick within the corporate limits as now established or as hereafter established in the manner provided by law shall continue to be a municipal corporation by the name of the Town of Brunswick, Maine.
