#### Chapter 135

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire and Increasing Salary of the Recorder of the Westbrook Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1909, c. 282, § 1, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 282 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended by section 2 of chapter 95 of the private and special laws of 1945 and by chapter 167 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Such recorder shall receive an annual salary of \$500 \$800 and \$600 annually additional for clerk hire, in full for all services as such recorder, which salary shall be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of the county of Cumberland.'

- Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1909, c. 282, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 282 of the private and special laws of 1909, as last amended by chapter 60 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Salary of judge and clerk hire. The judge of said court shall receive a salary of \$2,500 per year, to be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of the county of Cumberland, which shall be in full for all his services as judge, and \$600 annually additional for clerk hire. All blanks, civil and criminal dockets and record books required by said court shall be furnished by the county of Cumberland.'

Effective August 20, 1955

#### Chapter 136

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Recorder of the Van Buren Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 18, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1" of chapter 54 of the private and special laws of 1947, which amended chapter 18 of the private and special laws of 1939, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$\frac{\$\displaye0}{400} \$700 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'
